Recital 2023





Dear Parents and Students,

Rehearsal Dates: Mon. May 8th and Tues May 9th, 2023 at the High School, schedule attached.

Recital Date: Saturday May 13th, 2023 at the High School 2:00pm and 7:00pm.

Recital Tickets: Will be available for **pre-sale during Rehearsals** at the High School on Monday May 8th from 5:00-7:00pm and Tuesday May 9th from 4:30-7:00pm. You will get to enter quicker if you pre-buy your tickets. Any remaining tickets will be sold at the door before each show. **Payment in cash please**.

Recital Ticket Prices: Adult: \$15.00 Child (12yrs and under): \$10.00 Pre-School Free

Outstanding Accounts: All outstanding accounts **MUST BE PAID IN FULL** no later than **Tuesday May 9th**, 2023 for your dancers to participate in Recital. Thank-you.

Volunteer as a Class Mother and be entered to win a \$100.00 Credit for next season!! Students are required to stay backstage until they perform in each half off the show. We will need ONE mother from each of our 10 and under classes to stay with the children in the dressing room. This mother will be responsible for keeping the class together and quiet, checking for hair and make-up etc. There must be one mother in charge for each show. If you can be of assistance **please sign up on Picture Night.** Thank-you.

Showtime: If your child is performing in the first half of recital you are to have your child in the multipurpose room by 1:30pm for our first show and 6:30pm for the evening show. The class mothers are then responsible for keeping the class together, checking costumes, hair etc. before they are brought up to the stage to perform. The class mothers will look after the children until they are done performing, at this time they are allowed to go into the audience. Pre-school performers may sit with their parents for the remainder of the show if they are to shy to sit at the front. Also, for the show you are not planning to be in the audience, you may pick your child up from the multi-purpose room from the class mother. The dancers are free to go if they so choose after they have performed.

All children performing in the second half of recital will be allowed to watch the first half from the audience. A designated area at the front of the auditorium will be reserved for the performers to watch. These students are to be dressed in street clothes, but can have their hair and make-up done as there is enough time to slip on their costume at intermission. For the show you are not planning to be in the audience, you must have your dancer in the multi-purpose room by 2:30pm for the first show and 7:30pm for the evening show. They will stay here until they perform. The dancers can then watch the remainder of the show, or be picked up.

Recital Reminders: Please do not use anything colored in your child's hair. Brown or beige elastics and bobby pins that match your child's hair color ONLY please. Make-up should be done as it was at pictures but slightly darker as the stage lights take away any natural coloring. **NO JEWELRY** is to be worn, unless specified as part of your costume. If you are unable to remove pierced earrings, please cover them with a small piece of band-aid. Also please be sure your legwear has no runs, holes etc. in them. If you are in need of a new pair you may purchase them at Soles and Suits on Rose Street in Regina or at another dance store. Please purchase Mondor brand tights in the color you are requiring.

Reserved Seating: Each "Instructor" (teaching their own classes) and each Graduating family will be given 6 Reserve cards with their name on them that they will be able to use prior to show time if they so choose. We feel that this is fair as the instructors work many hours in preparation for the show and for the graduating students (Grade 12), this could very well be their last recital. Each family will get this opportunity when their time comes.

All other seats will only be available once the doors open, one ½ hour before show time.

Camera Equipment: NO flash cameras will be allowed at the recital as they are very distracting for both the audience and the performers.

Volunteers: Last of all we are in need of a few people to assist in setting up and cleaning after recital. The chairs must be set up on Saturday morning at 10:30am and then will remain until Saturday evening when they will need to be put away after recital. If you can be of help, please **sign up at Picture Night** and be **entered to win a \$100.00 Credit for next season!!**

Reminder: High School rules: No food or drinks allowed except water bottles with lids.

Regina's Recital: We have had a few people inquiring when our recital is being held for our Regina location. Tickets are available from any CBO box office or on line for our performances on Friday June 2nd, 2023 starting Saturday May 6th, 2023.

Pre-Registration for Next Season: Forms to pre-register for next season will be sent out shortly. By pre-registering it allows the staff to work on the schedule and get it to you sooner. It is best to pre-register for all classes your dancer is interested in as some classes may be overlapping once the schedule is completed. You may always choose to add or eliminate a class in the fall if interest has changed.

We would like to congratulate all our students that participated in the competitions held in Regina and Medicine Hat for a job well done!! Thanks also to all the students for their hard work and dedication throughout the season and for being such a joy to teach and to the parents for your co-operation. Without your support, we could not participate in the many competitions that are so valuable in learning to be a good performer. We hope that you have enjoyed your dance season with us and look forward to seeing you in the fall!!
